About WISEPlace

- Has Provided Shelter and Services for Unaccompanied Women for 31 Years
- Has Housed and Rehabilitated over 7,600 Women Since 1987
- Houses about 90-100 Women Each Year from all over OC
- Is the Only OC Program that Solely Addresses the Needs of Unaccompanied Women
- Plays the Unique Role of Rehabilitating Women Who Have Children So They Can Be Reunited with Their Children

Where Is WISEPlace in the Continuum of Care in Orange County?

WISEPlace Provides
TRANSITIONAL HOUSING
for Unaccompanied
Women

- Women who don't have young children
- Do not have the necessary combination of length of homelessness and a qualifying condition for eligibility for Permanent Supportive Housing
- Have not been rapidly rehoused when they lost their housing
- Are actively addressing any addictions they might have
- Want the tools they will need to become self-sufficient
- i.e. Those who fall through the cracks in the continuum of care!

STEPS PROGRAM TARGET POPULATIONS




- Senior Women Victims of Elder Abuse
